MINISTER’S NOTES

When God Sends His People

In both Matthew 10 and Luke 10, Jesus sends His followers into the harvest to carry out God’s work. These passages show a clear pattern for how God still works through His church today. When God sends His people, **He equips them, organizes them, warns them, and stays with them**—so that every believer can stay strong, faithful, and vigilant as they use their spiritual gifts to win souls for Jesus.

God **equips** His people with the gifts and abilities needed for ministry. He **organizes** His people, so the work is done with order, unity, and purpose. He **warns** His people that spiritual opposition will come, but that such resistance is evidence that the work matters. And He **stays with** His people, promising His presence, His protection, and His reward for those who remain faithful.

As each member of the church discovers and uses their God-given gifts, the whole body is strengthened, the mission advances, and hearts are reached for Christ. **Serving in your spiritual gift not only blesses others—it brings joy to the one who serves.** When we work together in the power and order of God, we become a church ready to impact souls for Jesus.
