**Text: I Corinthians 10:31-33 (NASB)**

<sup>31</sup> Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all things for the glory of God.

<sup>32</sup> Do not offend Jews or Greeks, or the church of God; <sup>33</sup> just as I also please everyone in all things, not seeking my own benefit but the *benefit* of the many, so that they may be saved.

**1 Corinthians 10:31 States:**

"So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God." It establishes the ultimate Christian standard: aligning every daily action—even basic tasks like eating—with the honor and praise of God. The principle of doing all things for God's glory connects to several other passages throughout scripture.

**The Christian Conduct Standard (Colossians 3:17):**

Paul echoes this exact principle, stating that whatever you do in word or deed, it should be done in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God. Colossians 3:23 Adds an emphasis on daily labor, commanding that whatever you do should be done heartily, as working for the Lord rather than for men.

1 Peter 4:11 advises that whether you are speaking or serving, you should do it with the strength God provides so that He is glorified through Jesus Christ, living thankful and generous lives.

## **John 3:16 (NASB)**

"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him will not perish, but have eternal life.

## **Hebrews 12:2 (NASB)**

looking only at Jesus, the originator and perfecter of the faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

## Philippians 2:5-14 (NASB)

<sup>5</sup> Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who, as He *already* existed in the form of God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, <sup>7</sup> but emptied Himself *by* taking the form of a bond-servant *and* being born in the likeness of men. <sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death: death on a cross. <sup>9</sup> For this reason also God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, <sup>10</sup> so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and *that* every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. <sup>12</sup> So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; <sup>13</sup> for it is God who is at work in you, both to desire and to work for *His* good pleasure. <sup>14</sup> Do all things without complaining or arguments;

## Matthew 10:34-39 (NASB)

<sup>34</sup> "Do not think that I came to bring peace on the earth; I did not come to bring peace, but a sword. <sup>35</sup> "For I came to TURN A MAN AGAINST HIS FATHER, AND A DAUGHTER AGAINST HER MOTHER, AND A DAUGHTER-IN-LAW AGAINST HER MOTHER-IN-LAW; <sup>36</sup> and A PERSON'S ENEMIES *WILL BE* THE MEMBERS OF HIS HOUSEHOLD. <sup>37</sup> "The one who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me; and the one who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. <sup>38</sup> "And the one who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me. <sup>39</sup> "The one who has found his life will lose it, and the one who has lost his life on My account will find it.

## Matthew 6:34 (NASB)

"So do not worry about tomorrow; for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

## I John 2:15-17 (NASB)

<sup>15</sup> Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. <sup>16</sup> For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world. <sup>17</sup> The world is passing away and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God continues *to live* forever.

## RESPONSE TO THE INVITATION OF FAITH:

- 1. HEAR the GOSPEL ~ Romans 10:17**  
So then faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God.
- 2. BELIEVE ~ Hebrews 11:6**  
But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he that cometh to God must believe that He is and He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.
- 3. REPENT ~ Luke 13:3**  
I tell you nay; but except ye repent ye shall all likewise perish.
- 4. CONFESS ~ Matthew 10:32-33**  
Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven. But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.
- 5. BE BAPTIZED ~ Acts 22:16**  
And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.
- 6. BE FAITHFUL UNTO DEATH ~ Revelation 2:10**  
Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.
